**A BILL**

To increase amounts authorized for commitments for the Paycheck Protection Program authorized under section 7(a) of the Small Business Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Paycheck Protection  
5 Program Increase Act of 2020”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCREASING AMOUNTS FOR THE PAYCHECK PRO-**  
7 **TECTION PROGRAM.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1102(b)(1) of the  
9 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (Pub-

1 lie Law 116–136) is amended by striking  
2 “\$349,000,000,000” and inserting “\$600,000,000,000”.

3 (b) APPROPRIATIONS.—Section 1107(a)(1) of the  
4 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (Pub-  
5 lie Law 116–136) is amended by striking  
6 “\$349,000,000,000” and inserting “\$610,320,000,000”.

7 **SEC. 3. EMERGENCY DESIGNATION.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The amounts provided under this  
9 Act are designated as an emergency requirement pursuant  
10 to section 4(g) of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of  
11 2010 (2 U.S.C. 933(g)).

12 (b) DESIGNATION IN SENATE.—In the Senate, this  
13 Act is designated as an emergency requirement pursuant  
14 to section 4112(a) of H. Con. Res. 71 (115th Congress),  
15 the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year  
16 2018.
